Practera Consulting Projects (PCP) is a professional skills development program for international students studying in Victoria.

3-week program where teams of University students work collaboratively to deliver a consulting project for a government agency, corporate, start-up or NGO.

- Expand social connections



Student Team

- Min. 50-hour commitment EACH
- (across 3 weeks)
- Organise and attend weekly meetings (~2 hours/week)
- Submit 3 project deliverables
- Teams of 5 to 6 students
- Self-directed and independent work
- Engagement with Mentor and Client
- Deliver for Client
- Deliverables ~3000-word equivalency



Who can participate in PCP?



About you:

- A currently enrolled international student at The University of Melbourne (e.g. not an Australian Permanent Resident or Citizen)
- At the time of application, either be an undergraduate student in your third year and above (e.g. have successfully completed more than 200 UoM credit points), **or** a postgraduate coursework or graduate research international student
- Have the appropriate IT and technical resources to successfully participate in Practera Consulting Projects (e.g. laptop and reliable internet connection)
- Have attended/watched the Careers and Employability Session on "Preparing your application" with information on Smart Resume and addressing Key Selection Criteria
- Have not previously participated in previous 3 week programs (previously known as Live Projects or Global Student Talent Accelerator GSTAR)



Eligibility at the time of application

Practera Consulting Projects (international students)

- Undergraduate 3rd year and above (e.g. have successfully completed more than 200 UoM credit points)
- ALL postgraduate coursework and research students

International UG 3rd year and above

OR International PG coursework 1st year and under Global Trade Accelerator (domestic and international students)

- ALL undergraduate students
- Postgraduate coursework students in their 1st year and under (e.g. have successfully completed less than 100 UoM credit points)

Common Questions



Can we choose our industry partner or client?

The matching process is done by Practera and not The University of Melbourne. Please note that the exact host organization and client you will be working with will only be determined once Practera receives student confirmations from the other participating Victorian Universities. Host organization matching and allocations are only done closer to the start of the placement dates.

If there is not a particular industry aligned to your area of study and/or interests, we would encourage you to take this opportunity to explore potential career paths and industries you may not have previously considered in line with the objective of the 3-week project consulting program.



Do we have to meet up as a team?

While in the past 3-week consulting project participants were required to meet in person, for the next intake July 2021, it will still be delivered virtually. This means that you will be working with your team members, your mentor and client entirely online.

If circumstances change, updates will be provided whether you can meet up and do group work in person. However please monitor <u>COVID-19</u> website for updates and contact program coordinator if you have any questions / concerns.



I am working/planning to work/studying over the summer, can I apply for Practera Consulting Projects?

While it is not strictly recorded, it is expected that students will spend ~50 to 60 hours overall across the 3-week timeframe on Live Projects with their project team.

This includes 10 to 12 hours (including deliverable feedback) of engagement with their project client and mentor, and ~6 hours of online content a week. The exact hours of commitment will depend on your project team and the project deliverables from your client, as this varies from client to client and are based on the client's project brief and guidelines. Deliverables are group-based.

You will need to ensure that you are able to make yourself available to participate in the University's and Practera's compulsory sessions to successfully complete this program.
